

Dear Parent/Carer,

**Re: Rapid Testing of Students (Year 11 students)**

Following our recent correspondence, we are delighted to be welcoming all students back to the Academy in a phased manner from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. Please be assured that we are working hard to ensure that the safety of all students and staff remains our priority during this phased return.

All students will return to the Academy on **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> March**. Timetabled lessons, start and finish times, and the gates used to enter the site will remain the same. In the meantime, the provision on site for vulnerable learners and children of critical workers will continue for the students currently attending.

Students who have consent for the COVID-19 testing will be invited onto site at specific times on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> March to complete the first of the 3 lateral flow tests that will be arranged by Academy staff. Students need to ensure that they follow the government social distancing guidelines on their way to and from the Academy on their testing day. There is no requirement for students to wear uniform for the testing, but they will need to wear a face mask. Please see the schedule for the lateral flow testing of Year 11 students below.

**Year 11** students with consent for the lateral flow test are invited onto site on **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March**, the testing will take place during periods 3 and 4. Students with testing consent will need to arrive via the Sparch Hollow gates at the relevant time. It is essential that students arrive promptly for their testing time as this has been staggered to ensure that we can maintain social distancing in the testing area. During this time, there will be no online live lessons for students as the teaching staff will be supporting in the testing area. Work for any Year 11 student without testing consent or for those working on site will be provided on the VLE. Online lessons will be delivered periods 1 and 2 and then will continue for Year 11 from period 5 onwards and will remain in place on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> March while we provide the lateral flow tests for other year groups.

Students with consent for testing need to arrive at the following times:

As per the government guidelines, please contact the Academy if your child has tested positive for Covid-19 within the last 90 days and does not require a lateral flow test at this time.
