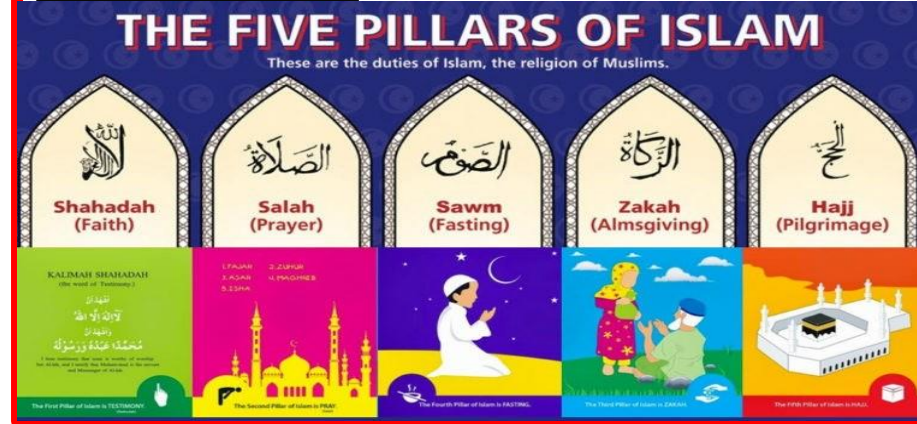

Islam and Peace- Not in my name

Islam preaches peace not violence. A number of acts of terrorism have happened around the world claiming to be in the name of Islam. This topic explores how acts of terror do not follow the teachings of Islam. For example:

9/11 - a total of 4 planes were kidnapped in USA, 2 flown into the World Trade Center (twin towers), 1 flown into the Pentagon and 1 was deliberately taken down by the passengers to stop another attack. 2,996 died, including people of all races and religions.

Malala Yousafzai defied the Taliban in Pakistan because she believed that girls be allowed to receive an education. She was shot in the head by a Taliban gunman in 2012 but survived and was flown to UK. In 2014, she became the youngest person to receive the Nobel Peace Prize.

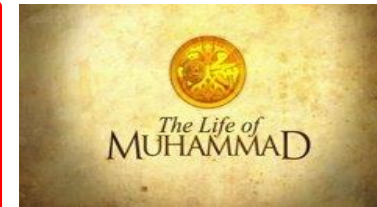
Muhammad

Muhammad was born in Mekka which is now in the country of Saudi Arabia. His parents, Amina and Abdulla had both died by the time he was 6 and then when his granddad also died, he was raised by his uncle. His Uncle raised Muhammad to be kind and generous, and as he often travelled with him on business, Muhammad saw a lot of the world from a young age.

But much of what Muhammad saw he didn't like. He could not understand how heartless people could be and how little faith in God people had. He was deeply religious, even as a child and would spend lots of time praying and meditating.

One night, whilst he was deep in prayer, the Angel Jibril appeared to him and told him that he had been chosen by Allah (God) to be the final messenger that He would ever send, telling people how to live. He gave him a scroll and even though he could not read Muhammad was able to recite what it said. Despite feeling very confused, when he returned home, his wife Khadija encouraged him to not be afraid to do God's will.

Although Muhammad tried to warn the people that they were not living how God wanted, they would not listen. He was often persecuted which eventually got so bad that he had to leave Mekka for Medina where people accepted his teaching. Here he became a great leader and even led his people in various battles against different tribes. He was a wise and kind ruler who laid down various rules about how people should live which is called Sharia law. After he died, all the messages that he had been given from Allah were collected and written down; this became the Qur'an.
