More money is being spent on the military in NATO countries.

On the 6<sup>th</sup> April 2022, The EU proposed a ban on buying Russian coal

Some 927 schools and other educational buildings

There are now over 3 million Ukrainian refugees

Natural gas and oil will become more expensive in Europe

Russian and Belarus imports, including wood, cement, seafood and liquor, are going to be banned by the EU

In the capital city, bodies of 410 civilians were found

Over 6 million people who are still in Ukraine have been forced to leave their homes.

Many people in rural Russia are poor and as such cannot afford to live in the same way that many urban residents do.

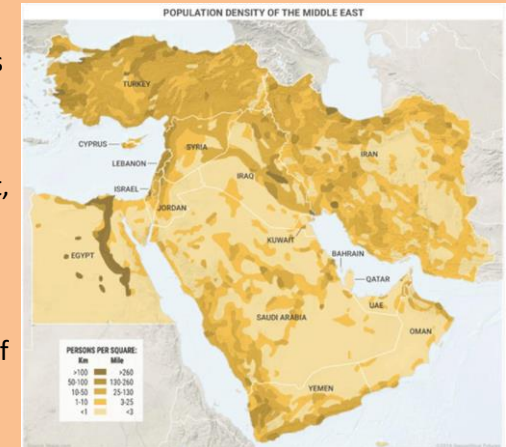
## Syrian refugees

1. Other countries have jobs and schools	1. No jobs for adults and no schools for children in the Turkey camps meaning no future
2. The news shows how welcoming other countries like Germany are to the refugees	2. It is their <u>home</u> and they feel attached
3. Unrest and lack of safety in their <u>home towns</u> due to the fighting	3. Many Syrians are choosing to stay- we can be together, unity

The war meant life for Syrians was becoming unbearable. Syrian children have seen relentless violence and brutality and as a result, have lost family suffered injuries and missed years of schooling. Although most Syrians have stayed in Syria, hundreds of thousands of Syrians fled to neighbouring countries, becoming refugees.

## Population of the Middle East

The sparsely populated areas of the Middle East are west and south Egypt, central Iran and inland Oman and Yemen. Qatar has one of the lowest populations.



The most densely populated areas of the Middle East are Turkey, North Iran and the River Nile in Egypt. The coastlines in the south of the Middle East are more densely populated than the inland areas. Overall the country with the highest population is Turkey.
