5. BREZHNEV'S HARSH POLICIES

- Brezhnev takes over after Khrushchev loses popularity
- Limits freedom of speech and worship
- Censorship and secret police
- Brezhnev Doctrine** - the Soviet Union can prevent its satellite countries from rejecting communism
- Also: make sure they don't get rid of communism

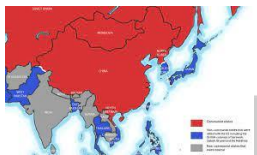

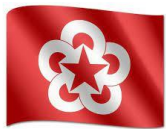
