Re: Key Stage 4 Pathways

Dear Parent/Carer

In September, your son/daughter will move into Year 10 and begin their Key Stage 4 studies. The start of the process is for students to begin to consider which pathway they would like to follow. We have many pathways and opportunities available and will be providing support over the coming weeks to help students make these informed decisions.

During curriculum lessons week commencing 8th and 22nd February, teachers will be sharing information on the KS4 pathways available in their subject areas. The information will then be available for you to view and discuss preferences and future progressions with your son/daughter.

Further details about the pathways process will be sent out week commencing 22nd February; this will include access to the subject videos, the Pathways Booklet and the Pathways Form, which needs to be completed by Tuesday 9th March 2021.

Subject staff will be available between 2:45pm – 4:45pm on Tuesday 2nd March, so you can book appointments via Insight to find out more about the KS4 subjects and to discuss whether the pathway is suitable for your son/daughter (details about how to book appointments to follow). We strongly recommend that you book appointments with members of staff for any subject that your son/daughter is considering as one of their preferred pathways.
