**Re: Induction Day- Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2021**

I hope you are all well and that you are enjoying your final few days in Year 6. I am excited to confirm we will be having our Induction Day on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September**. This will ensure that you are ready for your next steps to becoming a fully-fledged student at The Orme Academy!

On the morning of **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September**, you should report to the main gate on Milehouse Lane at 8:30am where staff will be ready to meet you. Please do not come in by the back gate on Sparch Hollow on this day. Parents/ Carers are welcome to come onto the Academy site to walk you to our main entrance at the front of the Academy. You will also be dismissed from this entrance at the end of the day at 3.00pm. Please note, for this day only, these times are slightly different to the usual Academy Day which is 8:40-3:20. Your parents/ carers are welcome to come in to the hall at the end of the day to meet your tutor and discuss how your first day has gone. Please be aware that there is no parking for parents/ carers on the Academy site.

On this day, only Year 7 students will be in the Academy building. This will allow you time to find your way around and we have some fantastic team building activities arranged for you in your form groups which will help you settle in and feel comfortable in your new surroundings.

**What to wear?**

You should wear your full The Orme Academy uniform.

**What to bring?**

You should bring your school bag and pencil case containing your pens, pencil, rubber, ruler and calculator. A refillable water bottle would also be advised. These can be refilled in the café at break and lunch times. There is no need to bring your PE kit on this day.

**What will happen at break and lunch?**

You will be able to use the café at break and lunch time. You will have your biometric information taken in the morning to enable you to purchase food, but this will take place after breaktime, so please bring a snack for break time. If you are wanting to buy lunch, please ensure your Parent Pay account has been set up and topped up. For those students in receipt of free school meals, a lunch will be provided for you. Alternatively, you can bring a packed lunch if you would prefer.
